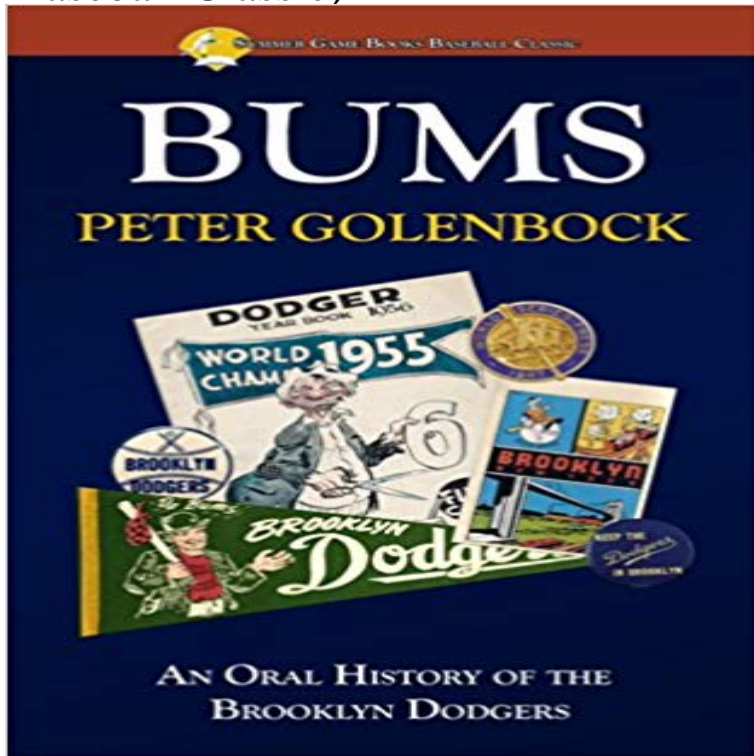


Bums: An Oral History of the Brooklyn Dodgers (Summer Game Books Baseball Classic)
