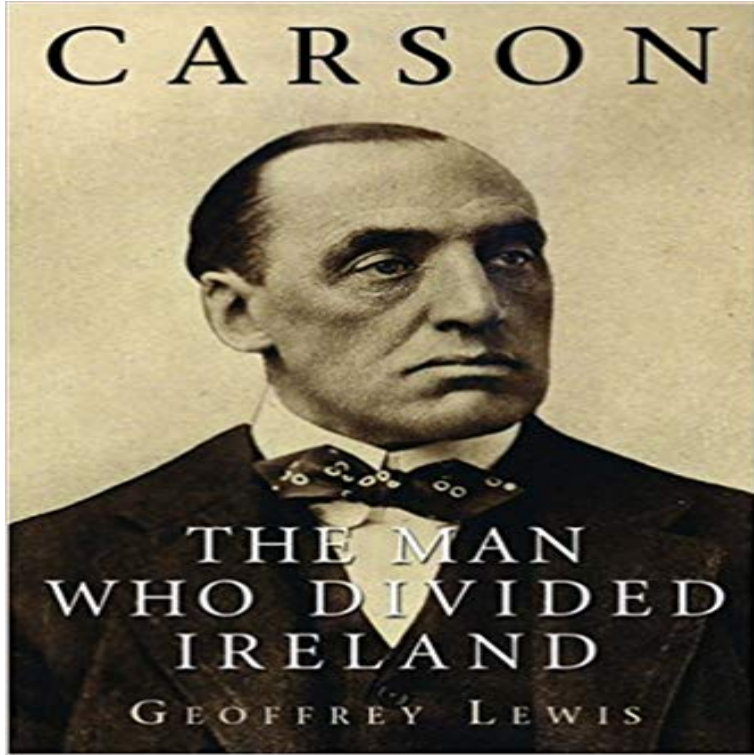


## Carson: The Man Who Divided Ireland

Born in Dublin in 1854, he was a brilliant lawyer whose cross-questioning of Oscar Wilde at his libel trial brought about Wildes downfall. An inspiring orator and political heavyweight at Westminster, his defense of Unionism in the years before the First World War, and of the rights of Ulster not to be swamped in an independent Ireland, made a united Ireland a political impossibility. While some of his actions were denounced in England as close to treason, Carsons idealism and religious tolerance were atypical of the sectarian bigotry that marred the later history of Northern Ireland.
