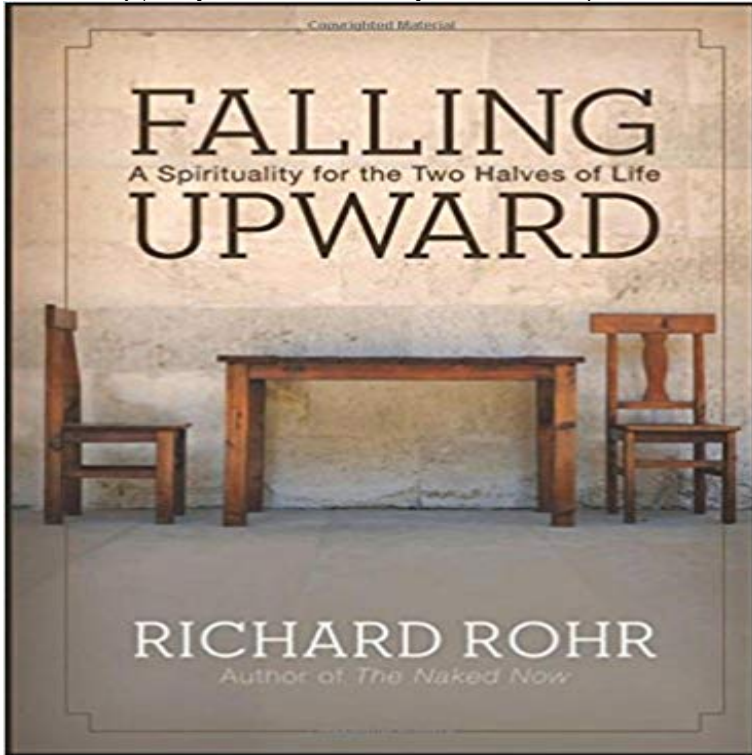


Falling Upward: A Spirituality for the Two Halves of Life
