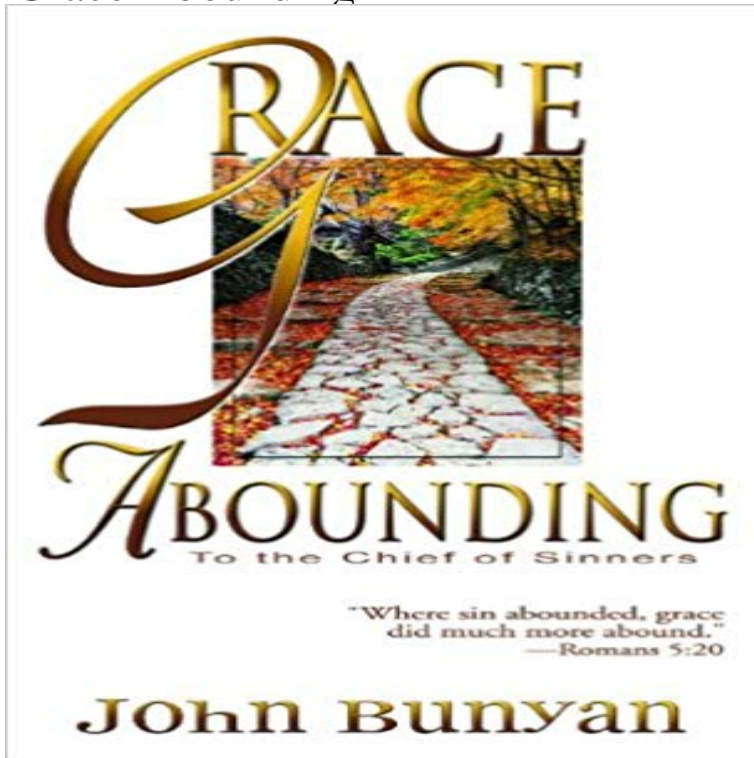


Grace Abounding
