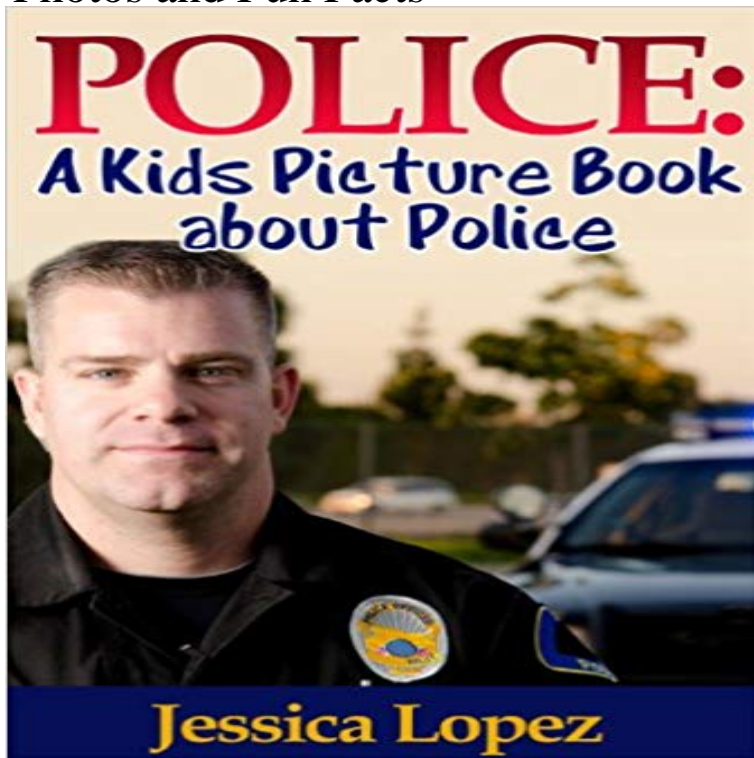


Childrens Book About Police: A Kids Picture Book About Police With Photos and Fun Facts

It contains a variety of facts on how modern police are trained, and their primary duties in today's society, as well as facts about how the first official police force was formed. It is illustrated with great graphic images. It offers interesting facts in simple language. Although the material is appropriate for these ages, younger children will need some help. They will enjoy the book most by sharing it with a parent. Students will encounter new words and concepts. They'll read about Sir Robert Peel and London Bobbies. They'll also learn about police dogs, and their work in K-9 units. Other subjects in the book include the kind of training police receive.

Most of the book's images are colored photographs. These are most effective when read on a Kindle Fire, or the Kindle Application on a tablet device, or PC. They can be viewed clearly on black and white readers. Only the color dimension is lacking. Children will also find answers to kid-style questions: What do police do besides catching bad guys? Why do the police get to drive fast, but you don't? Teachers and home schooling parents will find this book a wonderful addition to their nonfiction libraries. It provides selected passages on an assortment of subjects. Historical and cultural facts are all presented for the young reader. Great illustrations bring the text to life.
