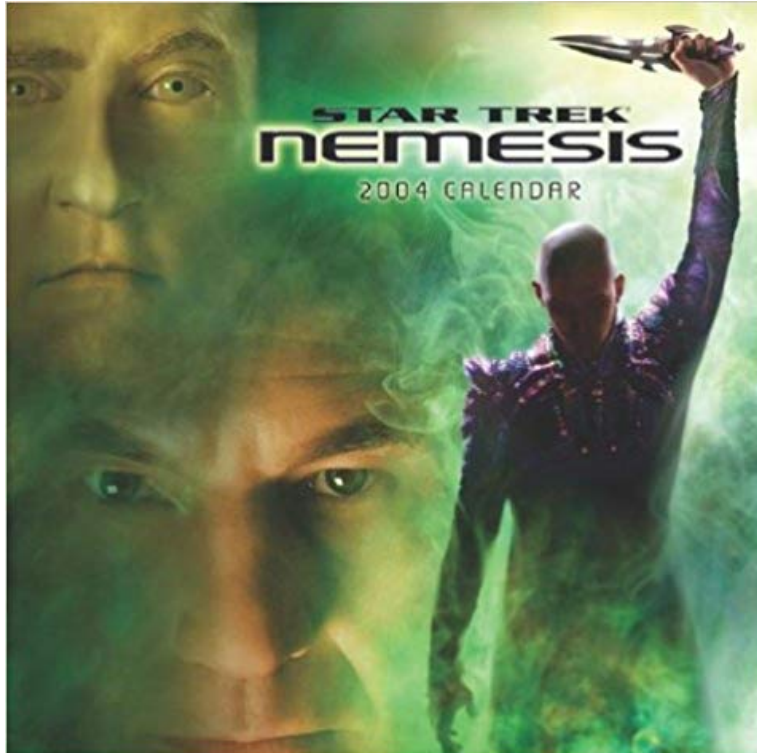


Star Trek Nemesis 2004 Wall Calendar
