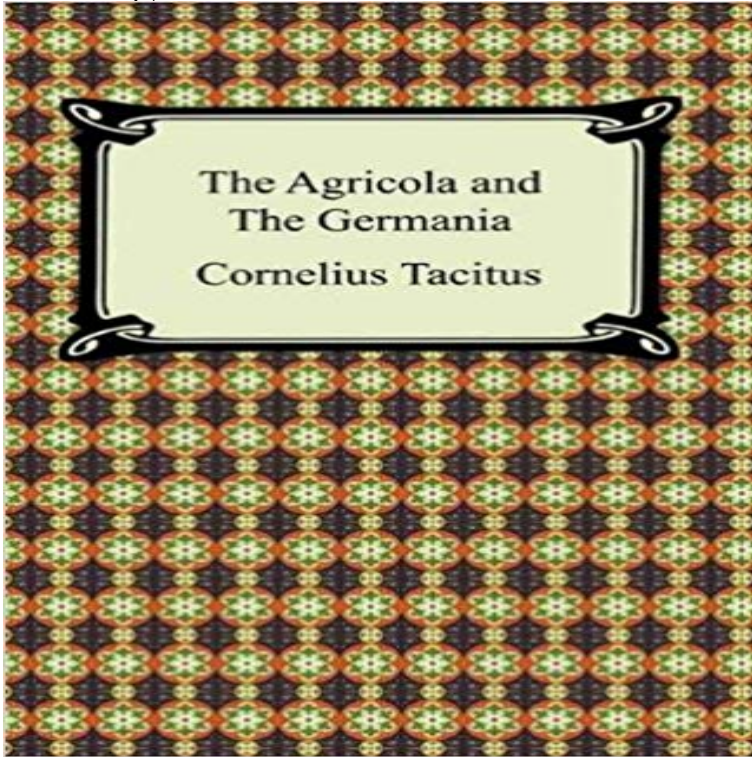


# The Agricola and The Germania
