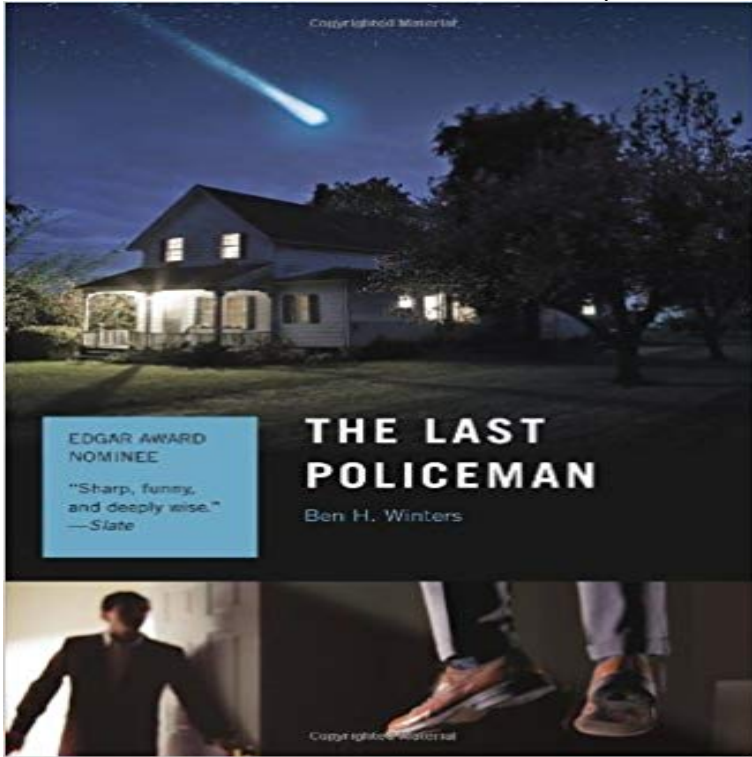


# The Last Policeman: A Novel (The Last Policeman Trilogy)
