Ansel Easton Adams (February 20, 1902 – April 22, 1984) was an American photographer and environmentalist. His black-and-white landscape photographs of the western United States are revered for their clarity and detail. Ansel Adams (1902-1984) was born in San Francisco four years before the great earthquake of 1906. An aftershock of the earthquake threw him to the ground, Adams considered his career-changing image *Monolith, the Face of Half Dome*, Yosemite National Park, California (1927) his first really fine photograph.
