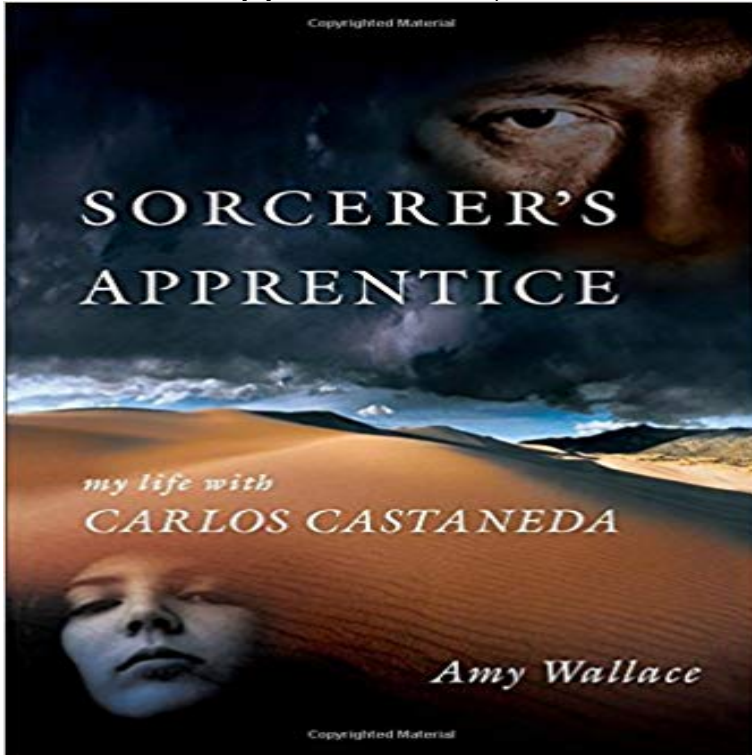


# Sorcerers Apprentice: My Life with Carlos Castaneda

Little did she know that a delightful first meeting would begin a 20-year friendship, followed by her descent into the dramatic and deeply troubled affair chronicled in this book. Sorcerers Apprentice unblinkingly reveals the inner workings of the Cult of Carlos, run by a charismatic authoritarian in his sixties who controlled his young female followers through emotional abuse, mind games, bizarre rituals, dubious teachings, and sexual excess. Wallaces story is both specific and universal, a captivating cautionary tale about the dangers of giving up ones power to a tyrant and about surviving assaults on body and spirit.
